#### Minutes

• Introduction and Welcome: DESNZ thanks the board for their hard work and time and thanks NIRO for supporting NIRAB.

#### Update from NIRO

- Gary Bolton goes over the GIF framework agreement. Negotiations on continuing GIF without Russia finalised in September.
- UK signed up to the following GIF programmes: Sodium Cooled Fast Reactor and UHTR Steering Committee.
- GIF currently under US leadership with Fiona Raymond appointed as Negotiations Officer and Paul Nevitt as Vice President.
- NIRO is developing a new site for both NIRO and NIRAB.

## Update from DESNZ

• DESNZ has nothing further to report to NIRAB as forward steps are still being finalised with the incoming Government.

#### Update from ONR

- ONR continuing engagement with NNL on the AMR programme, with Phase B due to be completed by end of 2025.
- Engagement with IAEA SMR Regulators to be continued.
- ONR is engaging with TerraPower and will begin to engage with X-energy in the coming weeks.

### NIRAB continued engagement with stakeholders

- First HTGR stakeholder engagement session scheduled for 15th January with regulators.
- Many government officials have already been briefed but these sessions can continue with any new DESNZ staff.
- Francis, Dan and Liv had a meeting with Lord Hunt, where they discussed NIRO, NIRAB and the HTGR report.
