    - a. AMR RD&D Phase A Competition
  - The ITT has been launched by BEIS and is available at <u>Advanced Modular Reactor</u> Research, Development & Demonstration: Phase A - SBRI Competition Guidance (publishing.service.gov.uk)

    - b. Future Nuclear Enabling Fund (FNEF)

  - Great British Nuclear have been tasked with building a pipeline of new build projects. Simon Bowen is leading a scoping exercise on what GBN will do.





- The Nuclear Fuel Fund: announced at Spending Review (SR), £75million with aim of building and preserving UK ability for the supply chain for fuels of today and tomorrow.
  This is still in design process but these complimentary programmes will come together.

- ONR/EA will be supporting the Phase A of AMR RD&D programme and have asked for NIRAB advice on scope. NIRAB are happy to provide advice on this topic.
